Nursing (Degree) Associate of Applied Science Program (TH)

Objective

The program objective is to prepare the student to enter the profession of nursing as a contributing member of the discipline to promote, maintain, and restore the health of clients in a variety of settings. This is an 46 week program designed for students who choose nursing as a career. The program's curriculum provides high quality theoretical, laboratory and clinical experiences ensuring the student opportunities to develop as a professional nurse and as an individual. 46 weeks is for core nursing content and does not include General Education requirements. The 46 weeks does not include breaks and holidays.
